Each Madruzzo room is unique in terms of size, shape, and charm: the structure of these rooms faithfully follows the original blueprint of the Villa, a unique characteristic that has been deliberately unaltered to preserve the building's historical flair. All the Madruzzo rooms have large, bright windows overlooking the luscious greenery and fountain of the central garden or the backyard gloriously embellished by rose gardens and ornamental plants.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

#### THE PLACES OF THE MADRUZZO FAMILY

The Madruzzo dynasty ruled the destiny of the Episcopal principality of Trento for over a century. From Villa Madruzzo, it will be possible to reach by car the other key places of the most important family of Trentino. By visiting the castles of Madruzzo and Toblino, the archpriest church of Calavino and the eighteenth-century church of SS. Mauro, Grato

and Giocondo in Corgnon, you will discover the evidence of the presence of the Madruzzo family in their native area. In July, it is also possible to take part in the "Feste Madruzziane", celebrations held in the town of Calavino, which for a week every year turns into a medieval village with traditions and habits of the past.

#### THE CHARM OF THE HILL

A stone's throw from Villa Madruzzo you can discover exclusive itineraries between nature and history. The Ponte Alto Orrido is just 50 meters away and is a deep canyon carved by the waters of the Fersina stream over thousands of years. The spectacular waterfalls and the play of light will make your visit to the gorge a memorable experience. However,

the hill on which Villa Madruzzo stands is also an ideal starting point for discovering many other fascinating routes. For example, you can travel back into the last century along the Great War path, with its Austro-Hungarian fortifications, or visit instead the ancient medieval silver mines. Discover the itinerary that best suits you.







#### THE TRENTO OF THE COUNCIL

Villa Madruzzo is geographically and culturally the ideal place from which you can begin your exploration of the places of the Council of Trent. You can relive the events that took place in the 16th century by exploring the places, palaces and churches that hosted cardinals, bishops, theologians and ambassadors who were protagonists of the XIX Ecumenical Council of the Church of Rome (1545 - 1563). Starting from the Cathedral of San Vigilio, where the twenty-three official sessions of the Council took

place, continuing with the palace in Prato before and then at Palazzo Thun, which hosted the preparatory discussions. It was instead in the church of Santa Maria Maggiore that the last phase of the work occurred. But the places connected to the history of the Council of Trento are many and include for example also the church of San Pietro, from which the inaugural procession of the Council and the Archdeaconal Tower, which originally was the residence of the archdeacons, started.

#### THE CASTLES OF TRENTINO

Trentino is a region particularly rich in castles, fortresses and ruins of ancient buildings thanks to its history and geographical position. From Villa Madruzzoyou can start your journey and discover the main castles of our province. The Castello del Buonconsiglio is only a few minutes away by car: the largest and most important monumental complex in

the region and residence of the princebishops from the 12th to the 18th century is a mandatory stop. Not less important and fascinating will be your visits to Toblino Castle, stretching out over the homonym lake, to Castel Beseno, the largest fortified complex in Trentino, or to Castel Thun, which dominates the famous Val di Non from a hill planted with apple trees.

#### THE GEMS OF VALSUGANA

Villa Madruzzo is the ideal starting point to visit the most precious gems from the nearby Valsugana. In a few minutes by car it is possible to reach the lakes Caldonazzo and Levico, awarded the "Blue Flag", access the cycle path along the Brenta and the

thermal baths open all year round, as well as enjoy regenerating walks. For those looking for another point of view, it is possible to book a helicopter tour to admire the valley from above.



#### ITS HISTORY

#### VILLA MADRUZZO YESTERDAY

For over a century (1539 - 1658), Trento was ruled by the ecclesiastical dynasty of the Madruzzo, prince-bishops whose political interests and connections stretched from Rome to the then Austro-Hungarian Empire.

After succeeding Bernardo Clesio, Cristoforo Madruzzo commissioned the construction of Villa Madruzzo in the year

of the Council of Trent (1545). Completed in 1563, the Villa became the summer residence of the prince-bishop, where he welcomed his noble guests. He was eventually succeeded by three members of the Madruzzo family: Ludovico

and Carlo Gaudenzio, who reigned with skill and prudence, retired to Rome in their golden years so as to leave their role to the designated successors of the family. And, finally, Carlo Emanuele, whose life was marked by his great love for noblewoman Claudia Particella, who used to reside near Villa Madruzzo. This is why he requested an underground passage to be built between the two residences. However, their love story did not stay secret, and the Pope did not

grant a dispensation for their marriage, refusing even to appoint Carlo Emanuele as Cardinal.

On the death of Carlo Emanuele, and following a landslide nearby, Villa Madruzzo was abandoned. It remained abandoned until 1882, when the wealthy podestà (ancient mayor) of Trento, Paolo Oss Mazzurana, purchased it. It was then that the historic residence

was restored in the classical

taste so appreciated in that period, and two allegorical statues still admired today were added on the frontal tympanums. Immersed in the park of centuries-old evergreen trees, Villa Madruzzo today is a tranquil

oasis, surrounded by mountains and vineyards, just 4 kilometers from the historic center of Trento. Two buildings have been added to the original structure: Garden - directly connected to the central Villa, overlooking the internal courtyard - and Belvedere - beyond the garden, connected to the rest of the building through the underground Madruzzina Gallery. Both in modern style, they nostalgically maintain the elegance of the original villa.





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
